The City of Bozeman offers weekly curbside landfill collections for items that cannot be recycled or composted.

While we aim to minimize landfill waste, some materials must still be disposed of this way. Our landfill in Logan, Montana, is 27 miles west of Bozeman, with our fleet making up to ten trips daily to offload materials.

Properly sorting recyclables and organics reduces trips and helps extend the landfill's lifespan.

What we provide:

- Your choice of tote size from 35/45-gallon, 65-gallon, 100-gallon, up to 450-gallon.
- Weekly pickup service on your normal collection day.

We would like you to:

- Compress waste to conserve space.
- Ensure your tote lid is completely closed when you place it at the curb.
- Place your tote curbside before 7am on your pick-up day.
- Consider using a bear-proof tote if you are in an area frequented by bears. Give us a call if you would like to switch your tote.

What goes into my blue landfill tote?

Plastics

#3-#7 plastics, non-bottle shaped #1 and #2 plastics, plastic bags, clam shell containers, pill bottles, bags, frozen food bags.

Other Items

Glass or glassware*, aerosol cans, ceramics, foil, metal hangers, lightbulbs, chip bags, Styrofoam containers and packing peanuts, food service ware, rubber bands, twist ties, dishes, utensils, empty and clean toxic product containers (oil and antifreeze, herbicide, pesticide containers), pet waste, diapers.

Unacceptable items

Please do not place these items in your landfill tote:

- Rocks
- Soil
- Paint
- Batteries
- Anything that qualifies as household hazardous waste

Waste disposal tips:

Household hazardous waste (HHW) such as motor oil, antifreeze, paints, solvents, batteries, and more require special attention for disposal. The Bozeman Convenience Site holds a Household Hazardous Waste event the second Saturday of each month from 9AM to Noon. No appointment is needed and it is free for non-commercial residents.

What goes into my brown organics tote?

All food scraps, food-soiled paper products and yard waste including fruit and vegetable peels, coffee grounds and filters, plate scrapings, pizza boxes, paper towels, napkins, paper bags, and yard waste.

- Please no diapers, pet or human waste, rocks, or dirt.

What goes into my green recycling tote?

There is no change to this service. As a reminder please only place these items in your green recycling tote:

- Plastic #1 and #2 bottles and jugs, aluminum and steel cans, cardboard, newspapers, magazines, and office paper.
