

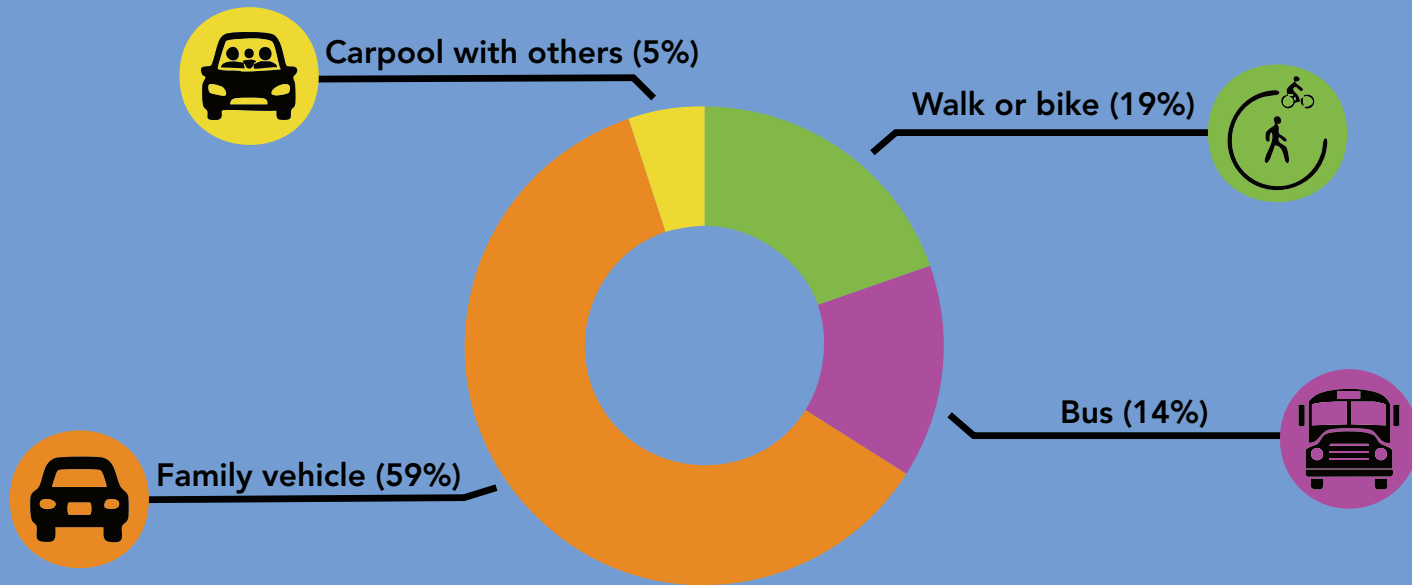
# Small Steps, Big Impact

## How Kids Get to School Matters

When children choose how they travel, they build **INDEPENDENCE**, stay **HEALTHIER**, and feel **MORE CONNECTED** to their communities.

## What Kids & Parents Say

Kids want to walk or bike to school!

**59%** asked to walk or bike in the past year

**75%** said, "walking and biking to school is fun!"

Parents agree, and...

**94%** say it's healthy

**77%** say traffic is a barrier

**YET... 44%** of kids are still driven to school



## What You Can Do

If you live within a mile:

- Walk or bike with your child, or team up with neighbors to form a **Walking School Bus**
- More walkers = more visibility = **greater safety**
- Work with neighbors and the City to improve crossings and calm traffic



If you live further:

- Carpool or use the bus to reduce congestion
- Try **remote drop-off spots** to give kids a short, safe walk to school
